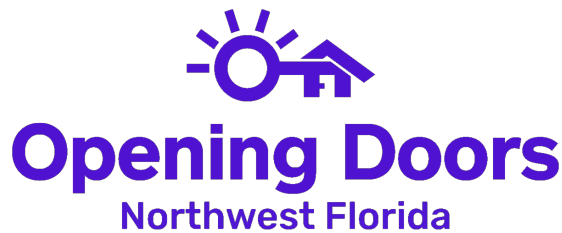

HUD's Strategic Goals

The five goals of the FY 2022-2026 Strategic Plan present the core vision of what we hope to accomplish, the strategies to accomplish those objectives, and the indicators of success.

- **Estimated PRRN:** \$1,798,966
- **Estimated Annual Renewal Demand Report (ARD):** \$754,303
- **Estimated Tier 1:** \$716,588 (reduction of \$37,715)
- **Estimated CoC Bonus:** \$89,948
- **Estimated DV Bonus:** \$179,897
- **Estimated CoC Planning:** \$53,969
