**HOW TO REQUEST FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THIS AGENCY LIST**

1. Check first to see if they serve your county.
2. Check times to call—most are early morning.
3. CALL agencies, NO walk-in service available.
4. Continue to redial until you either speak to a staff member or you reach the agency’s answering machine.

**Things to Remember:**

1. Agencies will screen calls to verify eligibility
2. Most agencies serve only once per year or per lifetime
3. 211 has up-to-date information on documentation required, eligibility, hours of operation, etc.
