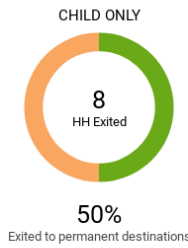

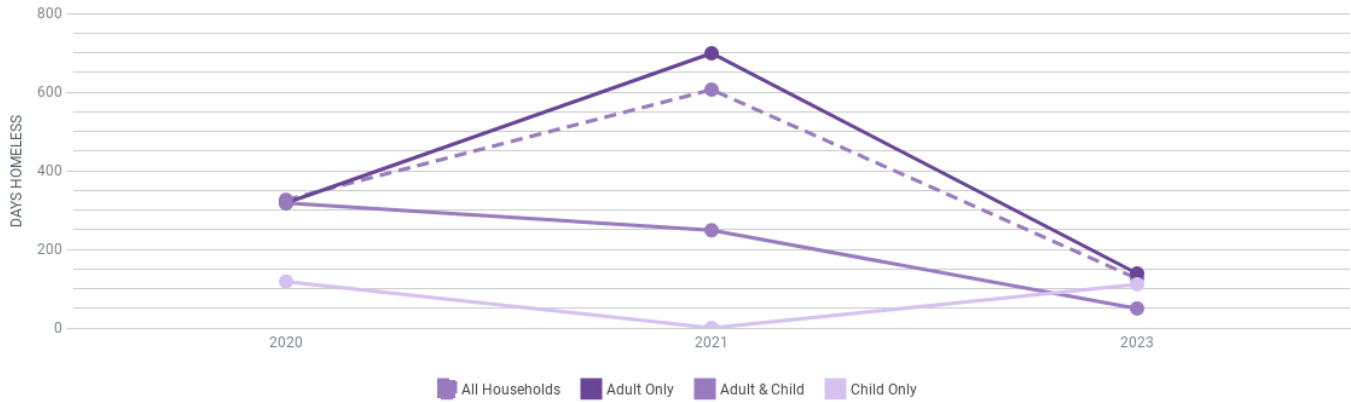

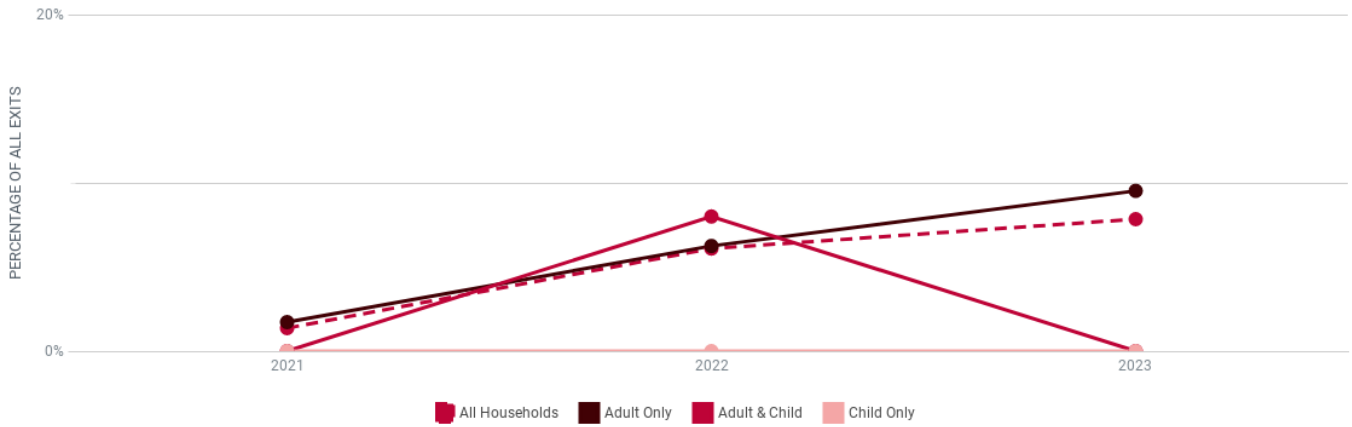
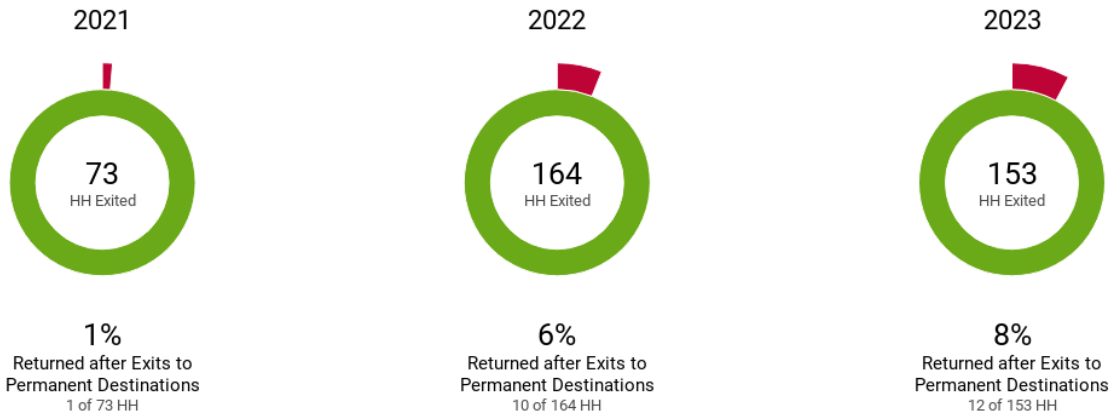


Days Homeless Trend by Household Type

System Performance Map

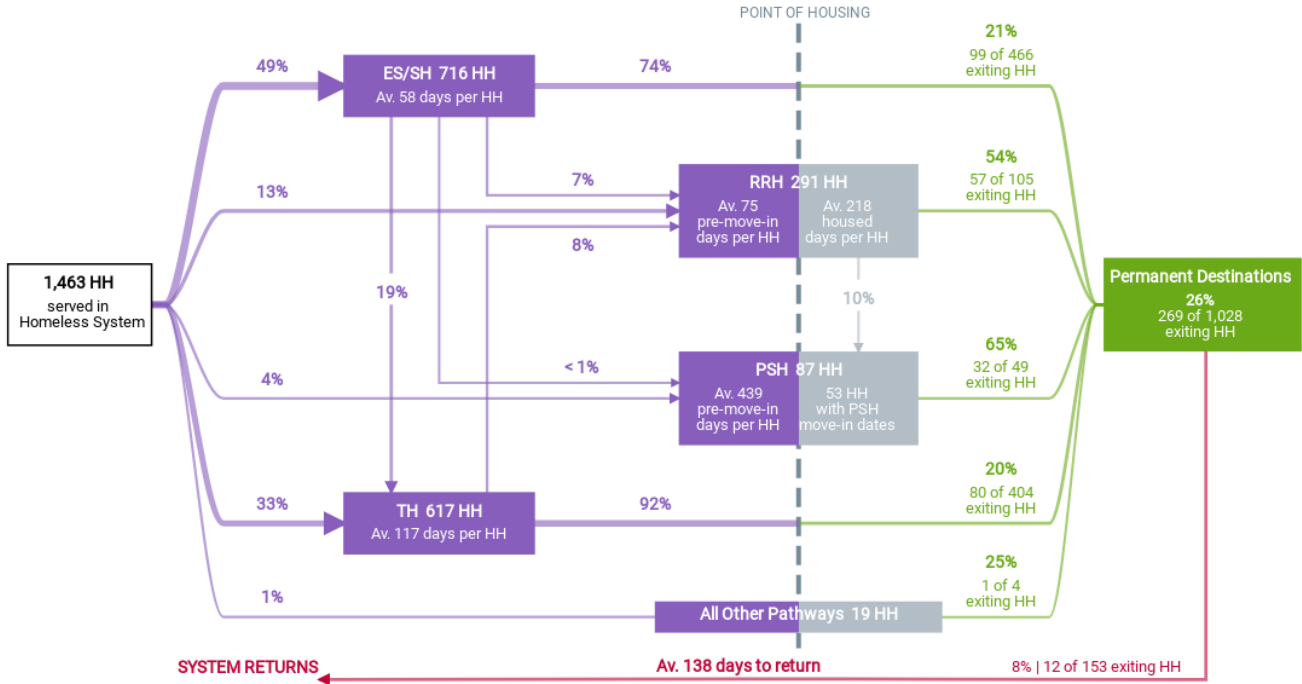

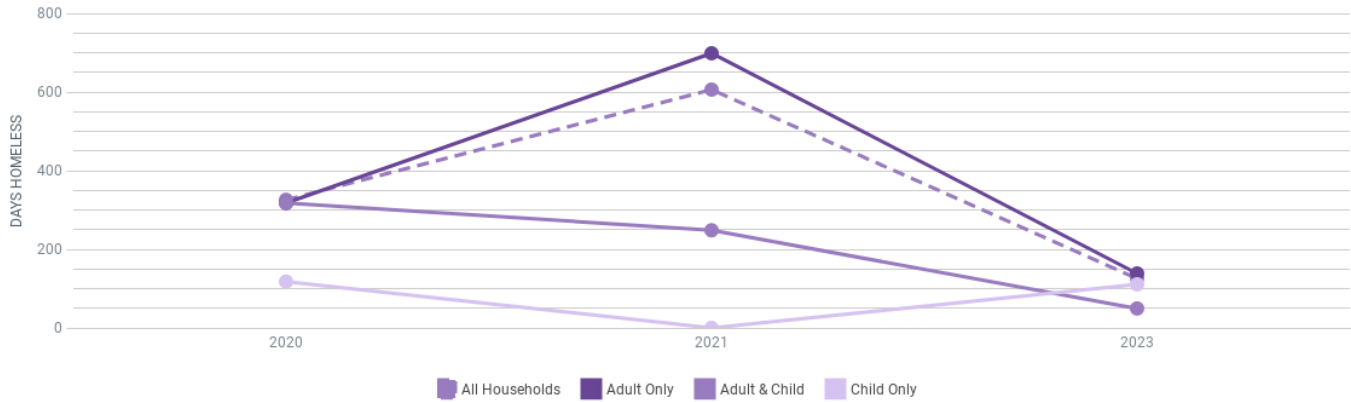

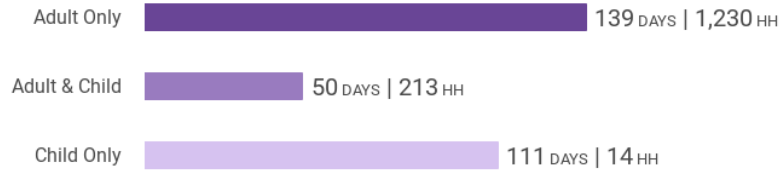

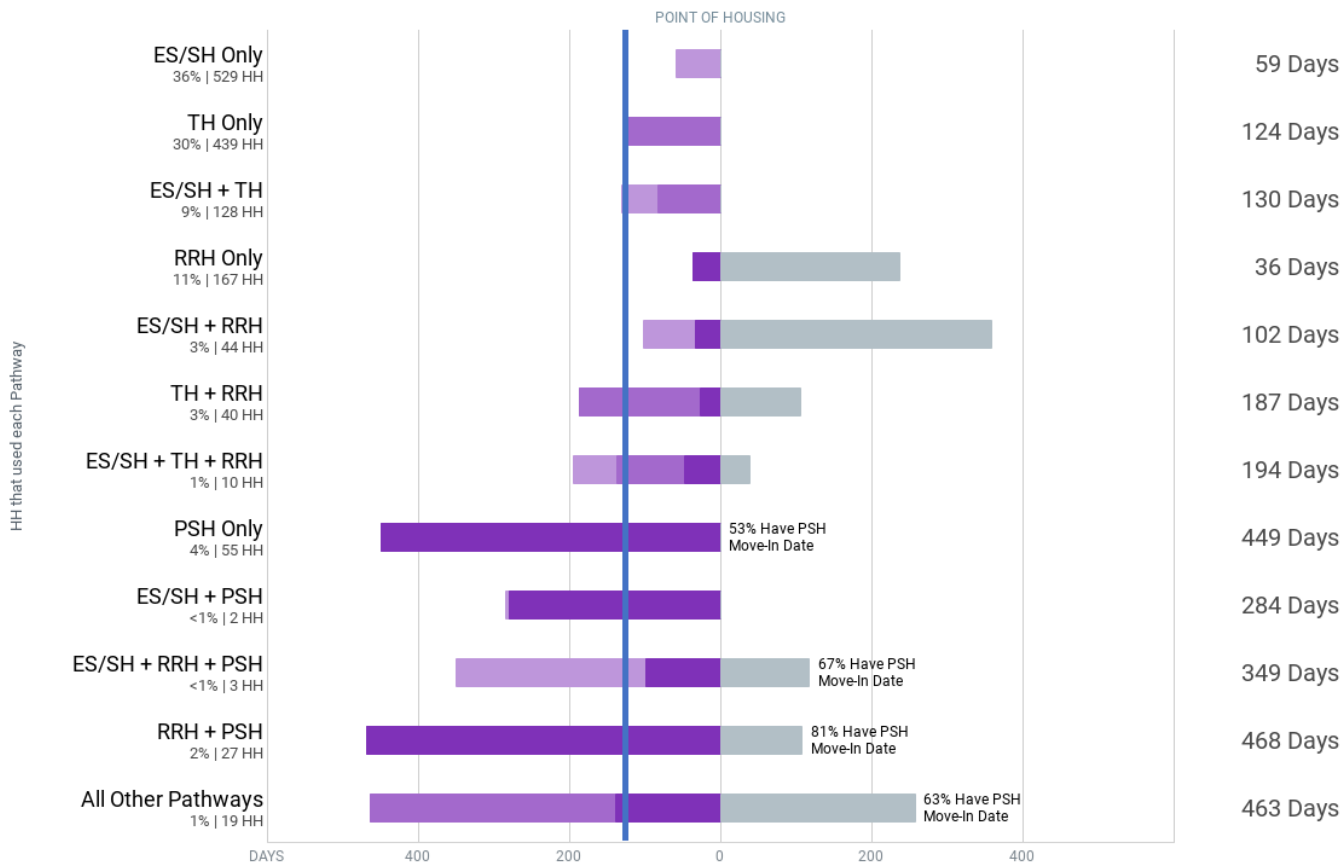

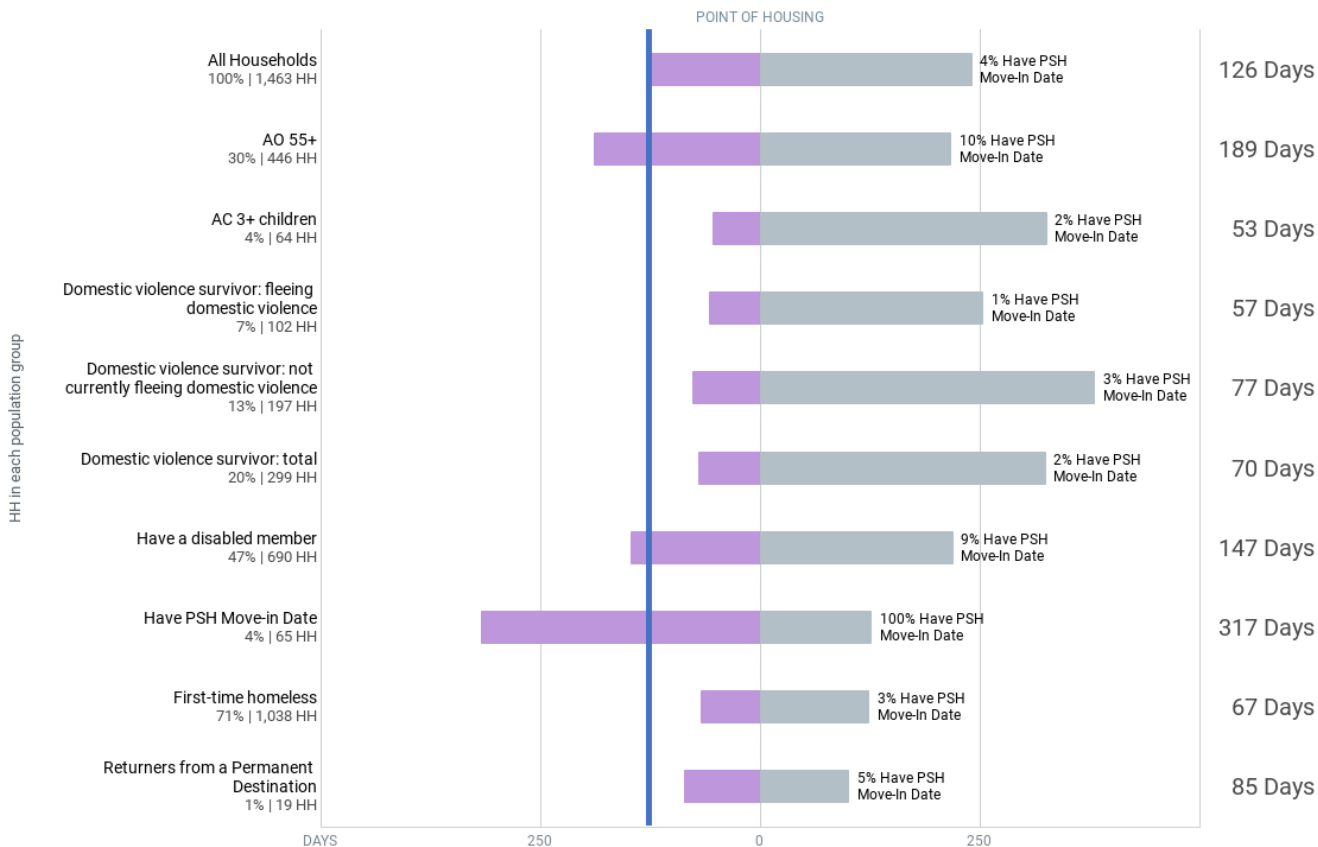

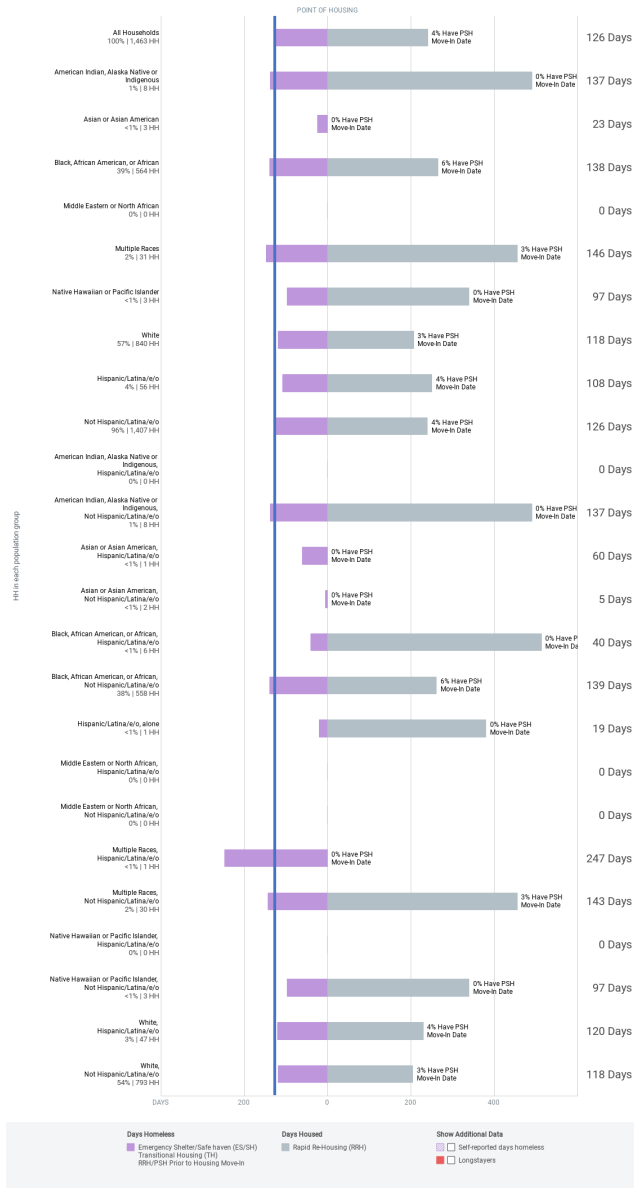

Percent of households that exited to permanent destinations.

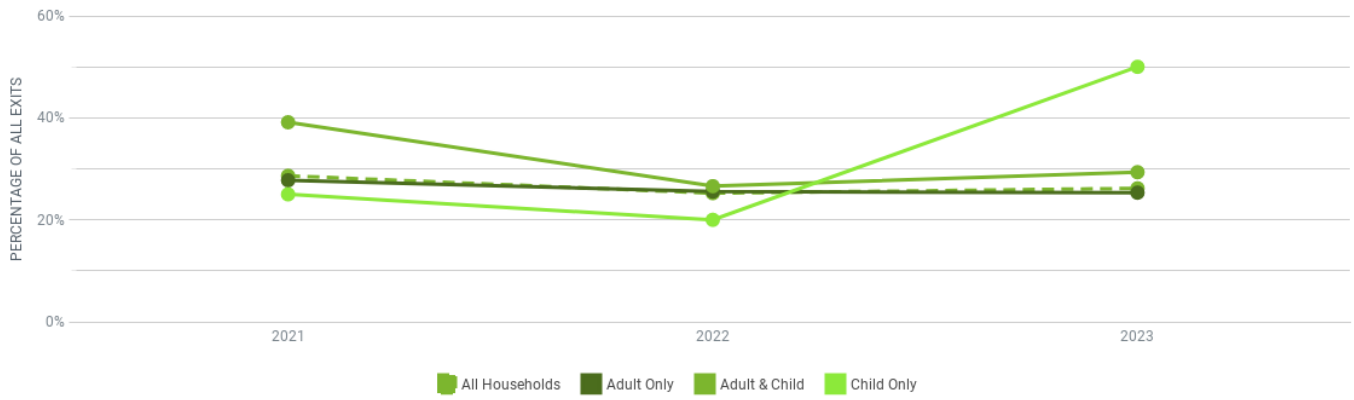
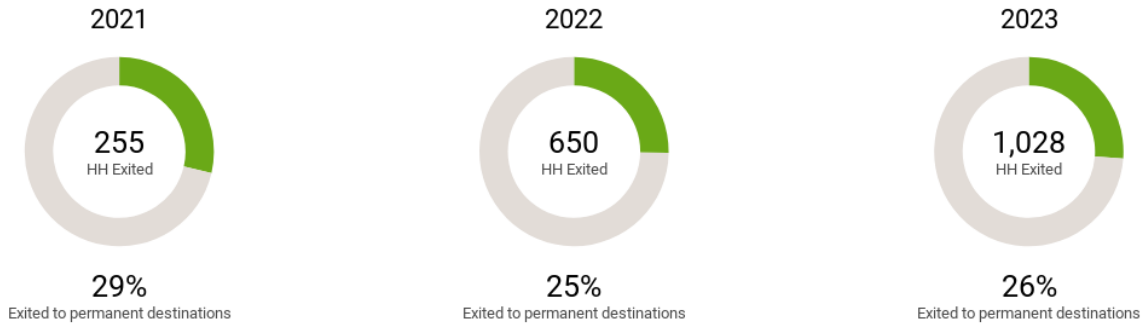


Exits by Destination Type

■ Permanent Destinations ■ Temporary Destinations ■ Unknown Destinations



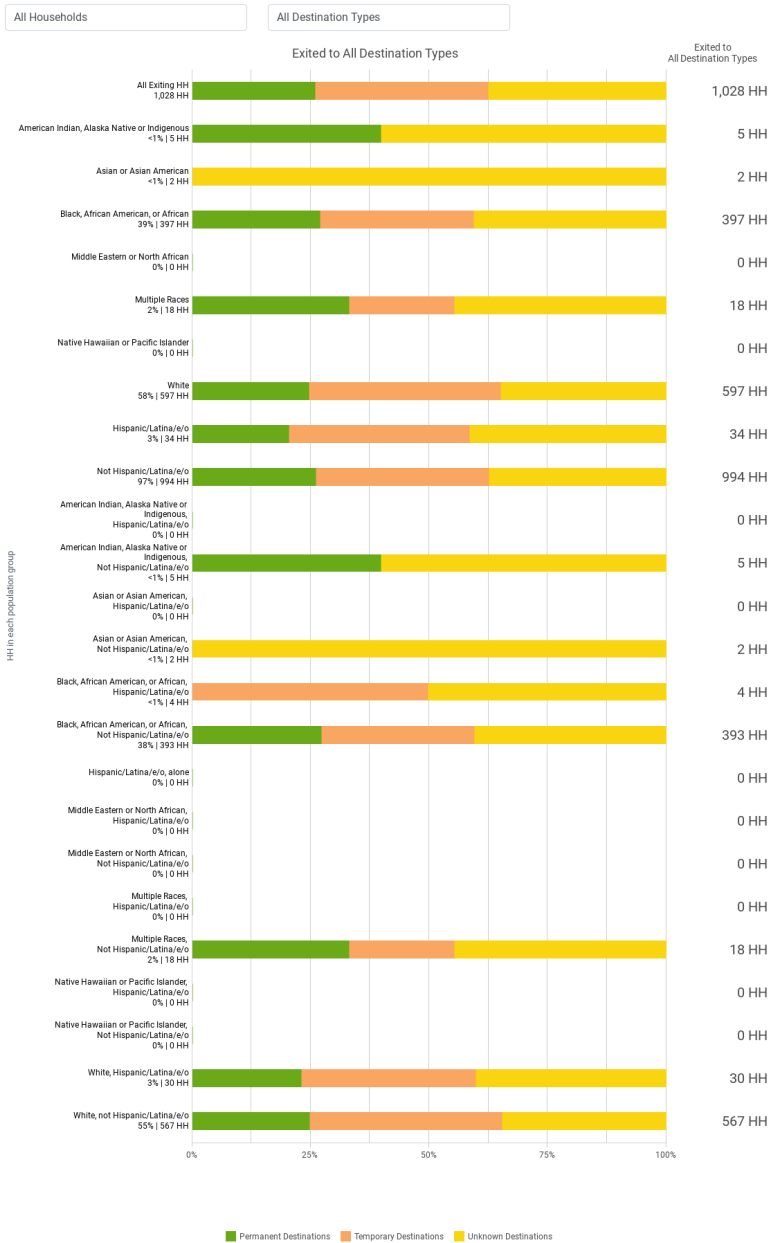

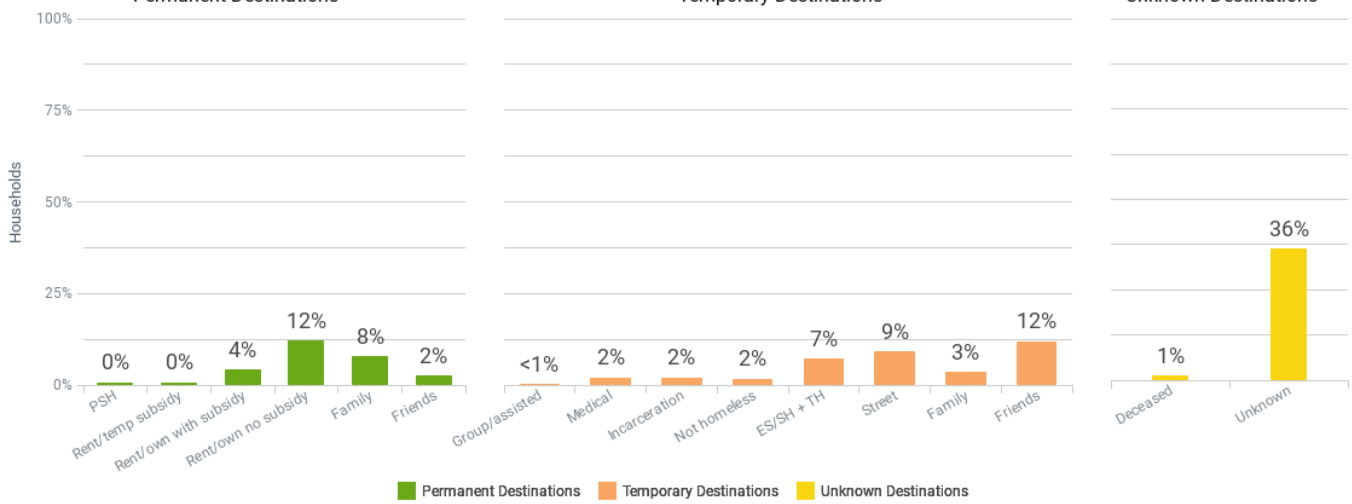

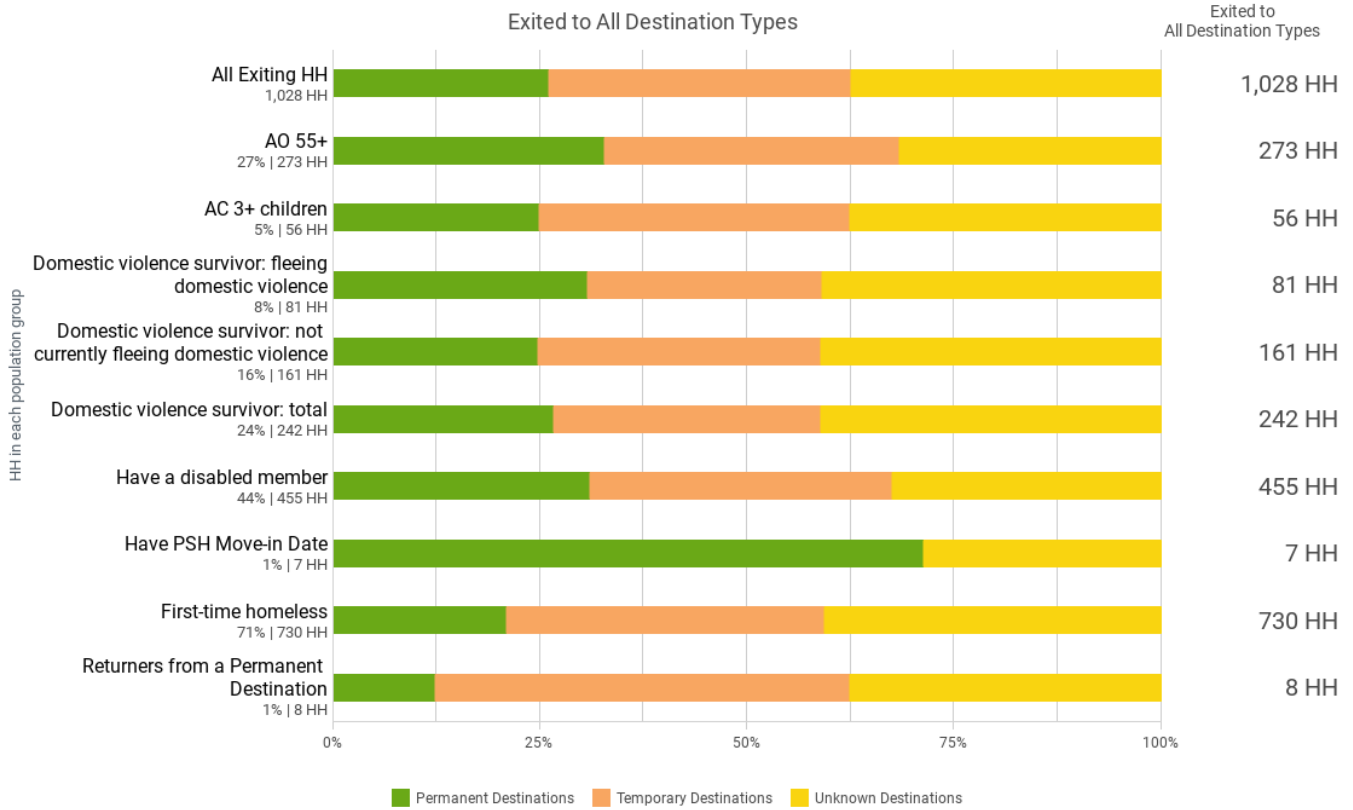

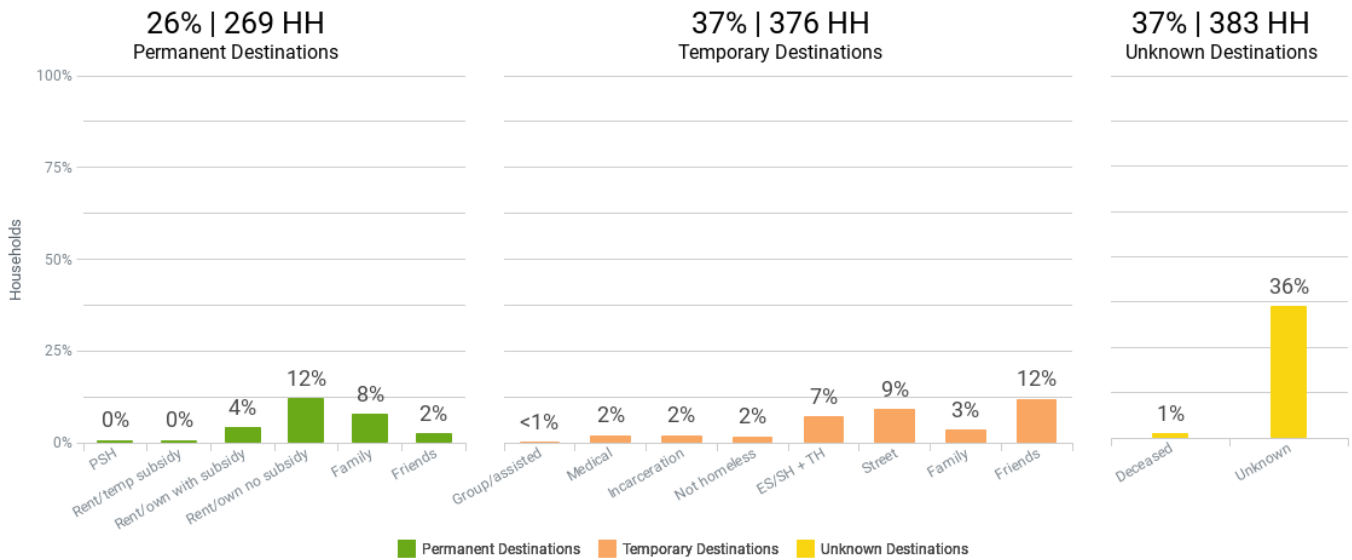


Exits by Destination by Population Group

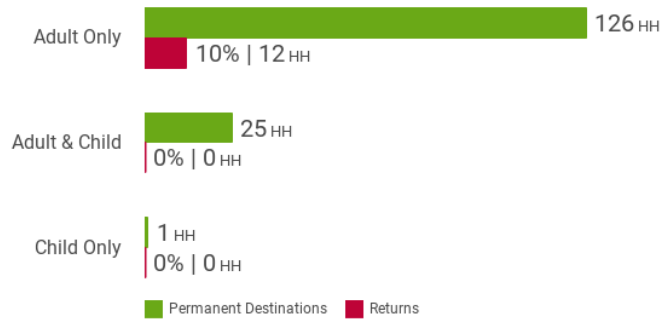

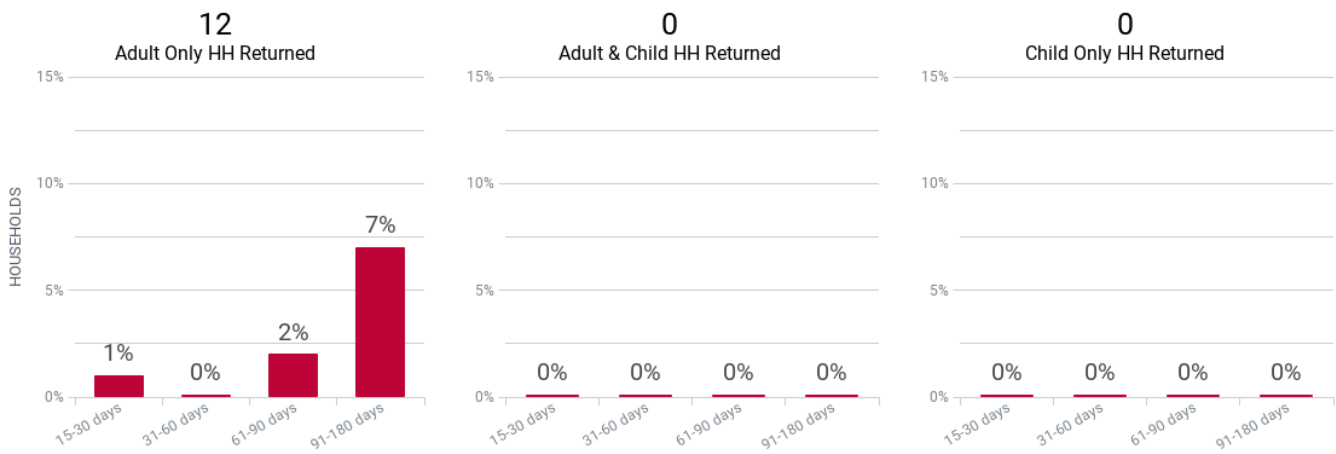

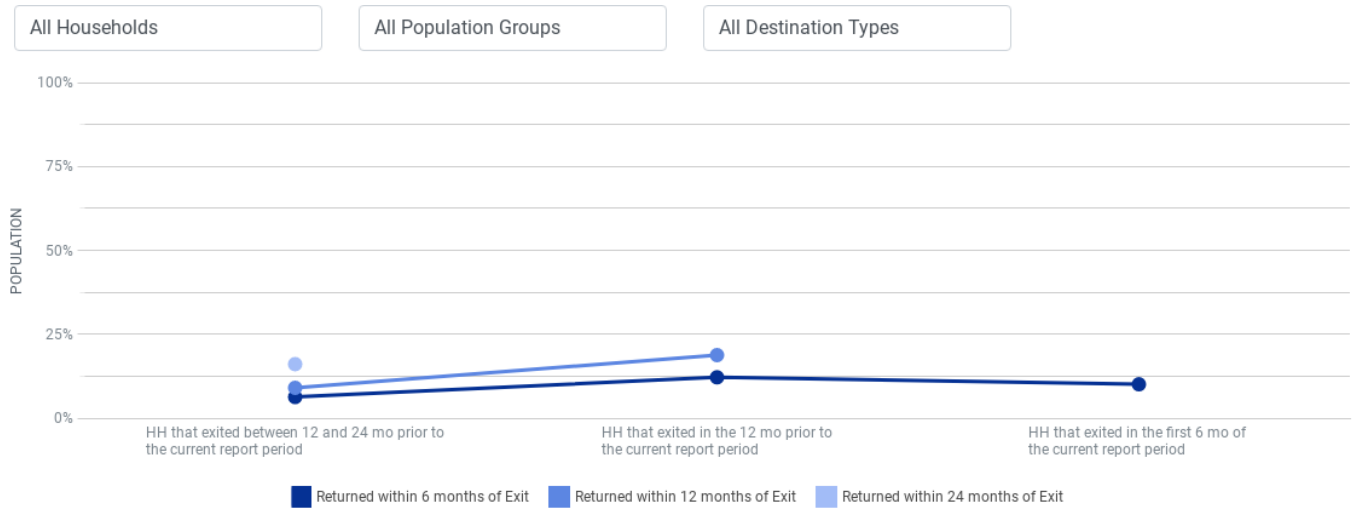


Time Distribution of Returns

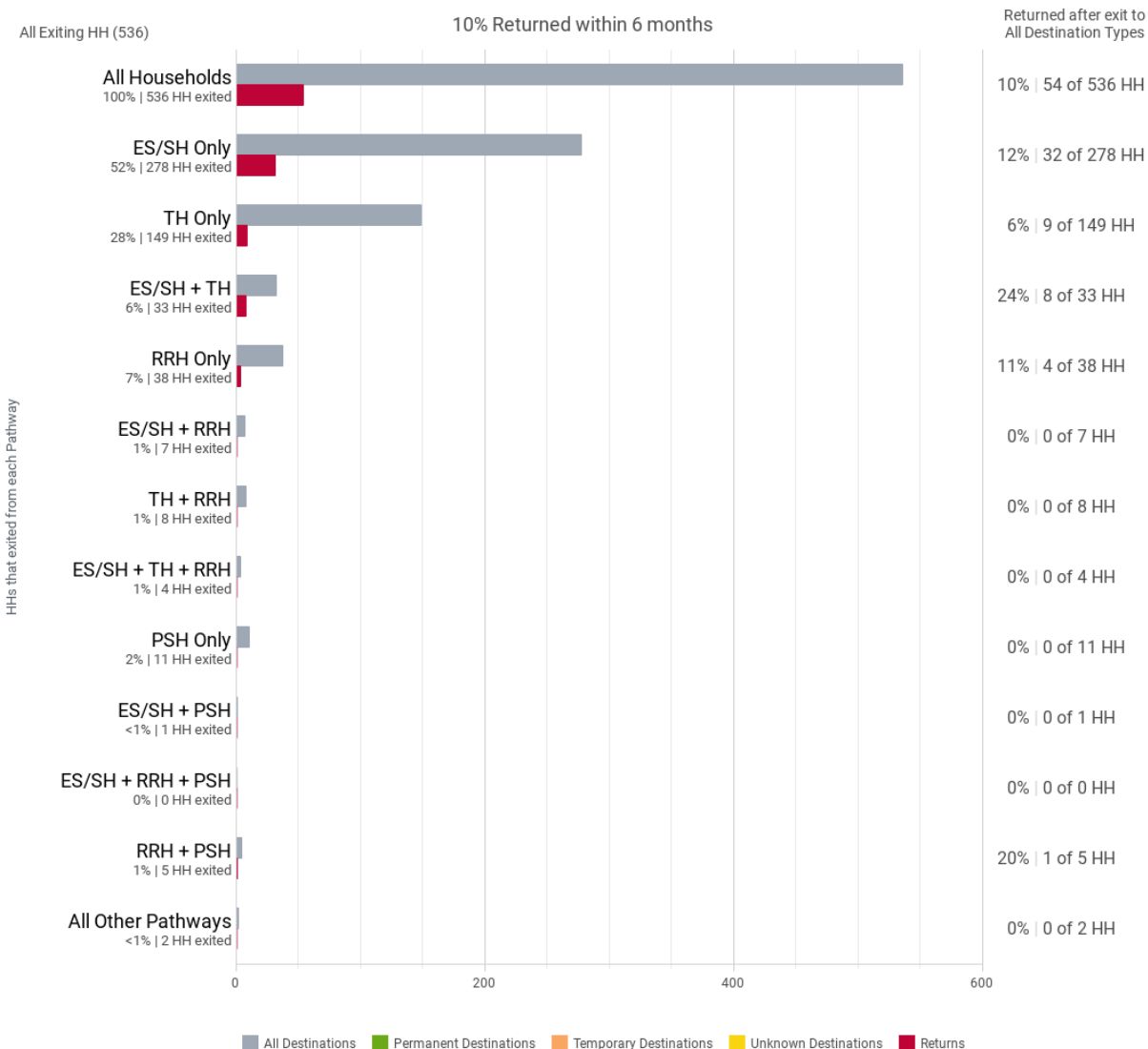

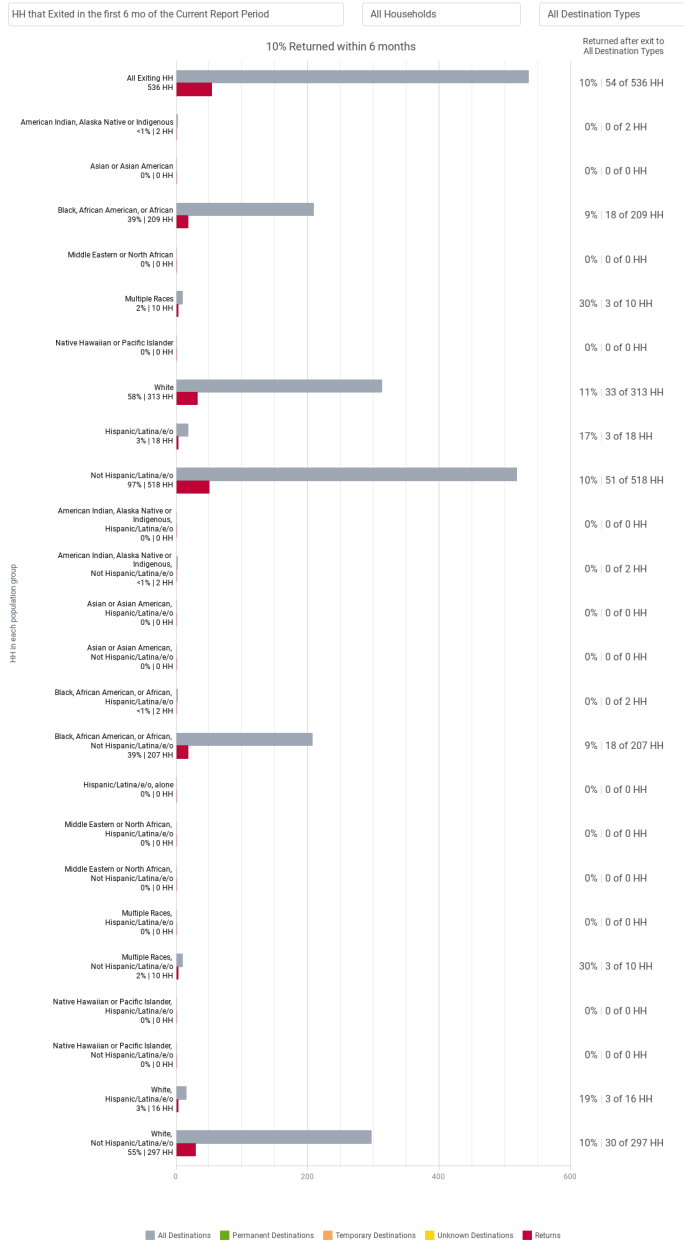

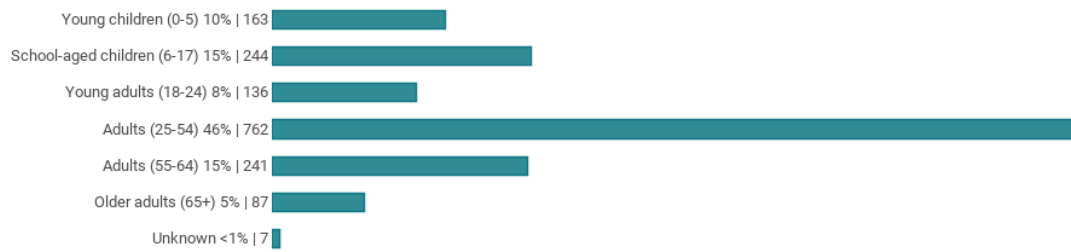

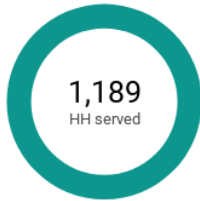

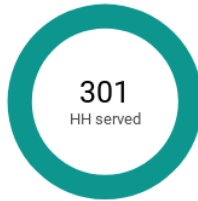

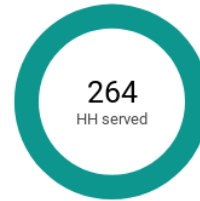

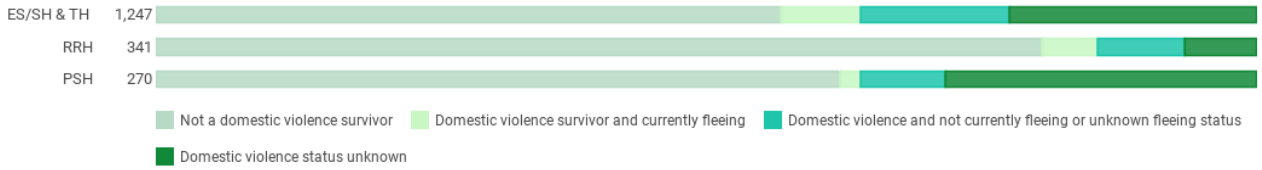

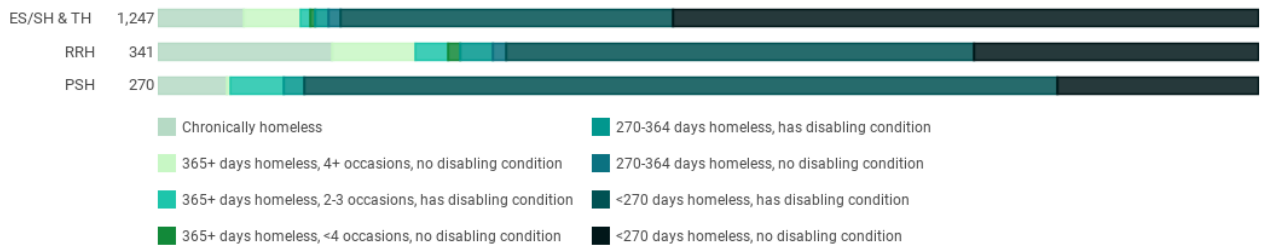

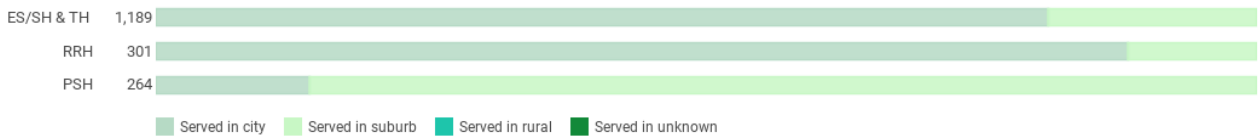
